

# Sevier County Summer Activities Guide



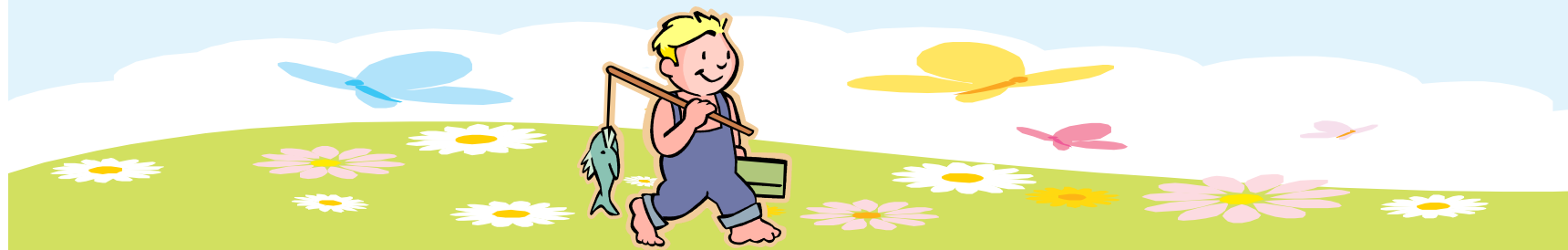
