

Wayne County Summer Activities Guide



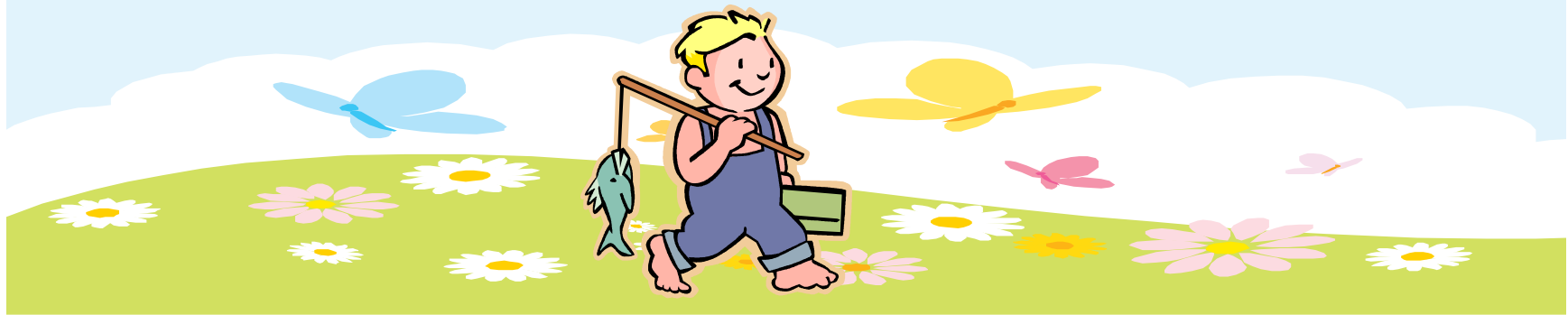
