October 3	Behavior Is Communication Instructor: Chris Weber	Social & emotional		Behavior is Communication class will be focusing on WHY my student has problem behaviors. We will be discussing universal strategies to address their inappropriate behaviors that can be used in every classroom. Our class will have a focus on how teachers can be more proactive instead of reactive in their classrooms, decreasing inappropriate behaviors from their students.
October 3, 10	Strong & Smart Instructor: Chelsea Oaks	Learning Env.	2 or 3	In this course participants learn practical ways to promote young children's physical, cognitive, language, and creative development in age-appropriate play and learning activities.
October 6, 8, 13, 15	Guidance & Emotional Wellness Course #4 Instructor: Brittney Nelson	Emotional Wellness	5-8	In this course participants will continue to learn about concepts developed by CSEFEL (Center for Social Emotional Foundations for Early Learning). They will learn about techniques, called Positive Behavior Supports, to help children with behavior issues. They will discuss the meaning of children's challenging behavior, and learn how to develop a support plan. They will also learn about the caregiver's role in supporting children with serious emotional disorders.
October 12, 14	Creating A Preschool Curriculum Instructor: Kris Evans	Basic Child Dev.	5-8	In this course participants will learn how to plan and implement a developmentally appropriate curriculum. They will learn about child domains, room arrangement, how to do a curriculum web and a lesson plan, and what a story stretcher is. They will also learn activities that support whole child learning in the areas of art, music and science.
October 12, 14	Emergency Preparedness Instructor: Chelsea Oaks	Health & Safety	2 or 3	Learn how to prepare for, survive during, and recover after an emergency situation to keep your child care thriving. Please bring a copy of your program's Child Care Licensing Health and Safety Plan for reference throughout the course.
October 20, 22, 27, 29	Strong & Smart Instructor: Kamie Adams CDA Cohort (Closed)	Learning Env.	2 or 3	In this course participants learn practical ways to promote young children's physical, cognitive, language, and creative development in age-appropriate play and learning activities.
October 27, 29, Nov. 3, 5	Learning To Get Along Instructor: Kristy DeGraaf	Social & Emotional	2 or 3	In this course participants learn effective strategies for supporting young children's social and emotional development. Areas of focus include: fostering self-esteem and independence, learning to get along in a group, and behavioral guidance.
