September 12	Behavior Is Communication Instructor: Chris Weber	Social & Emotional		Behavior is Communication class will be focusing on WHY my student has problem behaviors. We will be discussing universal strategies to address their inappropriate behaviors that can be used in every classroom. Our class will focus on how teachers can be more proactive instead of reactive in their classrooms, decreasing inappropriate behaviors from their students.
September 14, 16, 21, 23	Healthy Care Instructor: Kristy DeGraaf	Health & Safety	1-3	In this course participants will learn about child care health and safety issues. Topics include: communicable diseases, SIDS, shaken baby syndrome, child abuse and neglect, injury prevention, emergency procedures, nutrition, sick children, and medication administration.
September 15, 17, 22, 24	Theory & Best Practices Course #1 Instructor: Brionne Neilson	Child Dev.	5-8	In this course, participants will gain an understanding of Maslow's Hierarchy of Needs and how to apply it in real-life situations. Participants will also learn about the work of Mary Ainsworth and John Bowlby around Attachment Theory and how attachment affects development.
September 15, 17, 29, Oct. 1	Unlocking the Creative Mind Instructor: Kim Hanson	Learning Environments	5-8	In this course participants will learn the value of creative art, dramatic play, creative movement, music and dance, and the important roles they play in a young child's life
September 21, 23, 28, 30	All About Twos Instructor: Brionne Neilson	Child Dev.	1-8	This course focuses on the unique needs of two year olds and how to be a successful caregiver to two year old children. Participants will learn how to promote language-cognitive-social and emotional development, and how to create an environment that supports two year old needs and caregiver sanity.

Instructor: Kamie Adams CDA Cohort CLOSED	Child Dev.	2 or 3	In this course participants learn how to set up center and home-based child care programs to encourage play, exploration, and learning. Information is included on spaces and materials for block play, dramatic play, puzzles, games, books and literacy activities, art, sensory play, and outdoor play.
September 28, 30	What Do You Do With The Mad That You Feel? Instructor: Brionne Neilson	Social & Emotional	5-8	In this course participants will learn that controlling anger is a skill that children learn from their caregivers. They will develop an understanding of how to develop their own self-control, and examine ways to help children develop self-control. Lastly, they will learn strategies for intervention when children are overwhelmed with anger and frustration.
