Participants will learn about the 5 R's of responsive caregiving (relationships, responsive interactions, routines, respect and repetition) and will practice using the 5 R's to respond to common challenging behaviors. Participants will learn about the crucial brain development that occurs between birth and age three and strategies for brain-building through loving relationships and age-appropriate activities.
